The hotel also offers guests and visitors ENVi environmentally sustainable waterless car washes to help address the California water shortage. A traditional car wash uses 47 gallons of water and the run off contributes to water pollution. The ENVi sustainable wash requires no water, and only eight ounces of locally produced, biodegradable cleaner.

"At The Peninsula Beverly Hills, our priority is to deliver the highest standard of luxury in a sustainable and responsible way," adds Managing Director Offer Nissenbaum. "Our partnership with ENVi is a seamless extension of our commitment to taking proactive measures to aid our water-stressed environment."

Waterless carwash services will be available every day at The Peninsula Beverly Hills from April 22, 2018. Prices start at \$45 and a portion of every sale will be donated to Water.org, a non-profit organization founded by Gary White and Matt Damon, dedicated to creating water equality worldwide.

The Peninsula Beverly Hills also partners with "Clean the World," an organization that collects and recycles used soaps and bottled amenities. The soaps and cleaning products are picked up each month and sanitized, re-packaged and distributed within 60 days to children and families in more than 40 countries, including the United States and Canada. By recycling and sanitizing soaps, shampoos and conditioners, thousands of children around the world can be protected from deadly illnesses each day.
